You have been selected as a prospective loan recipient under the 2026 Oosakafu Ikueikai reserved scholarship program, as detailed below.

- Enrollment incremental scholarship loan: Eligible (You are eligible to borrow up to the following amounts.)
National/public school: 100,000 yen
Private school: 370,000 yen
Private correspondence program: 270,000 yen
 - Scholarship loan: Eligible (You are eligible for this loan regardless of whether you enroll in a public or private school.)

- Please note that the submission destination, submission period, etc. differ depending on the type of scholarship.
- If the applicant does not complete the procedures within the submission period, the applicant will be considered to have declined the loan. (The applicant will not be eligible for a loan.)

For those who have applied only for the enrollment incremental scholarship loan (i.e., those who did not apply for the scholarship loan), please submit a copy of your student ID card (the portion showing your name and school name), with the application number written on the copy, to Oosakafu Ikueikai by Thursday, April 30, so that we can confirm your enrollment in the school you were admitted to. (If you fail to submit it, loan repayment will be required from October 2026.)

Submission of the documents required to apply for the enrollment incremental scholarship loan

Please submit the documents required to apply for the enrollment incremental scholarship loan to Oosakafu Ikueikai within the period indicated on the front page using the enclosed submission envelope.

(Please refrain from submitting the required documents in person).

We send letters to private high schools requesting extensions of payment deadlines for entrance fees, etc. and other special considerations on behalf of our "prospective recipients of the enrollment incremental scholarship loan."

If you have any concerns about paying entrance fees, etc., please be sure to consult in advance with the school you plan to attend.

(This year, we plan to send the above letters on Wednesday, December 17, 2025. The letters will be sent to schools that our scholarship recipients have attended in recent years, not to all schools.)

Timing of disbursement	Scholarship funds will be transferred to the applicant's bank account on Monday, June 1, 2026.
